### **Camp 1**

Camp 1 is designed to work on the basic fundamentals of dribbling, passing, shooting and defense throughout the entire summer. Basketball is a game of repetition and this camp will give players two days a week to get in the gym, work on their skills, and play some games. The first half of each session will be working on skills and competing in contests to put those skills to work. The second half of each session will be playing a variety of games; 2 on 2, 3 on 3, and 5 on 5. This will be enjoyable for the campers, but will also help players get to the next level if they wish to.

### **Camp 2**

Camp 2 is designed to take everything learned in Camp 1 and build on it with some more advanced ideas and concepts. We will go more in depth and also learn more about the game as a whole, not just as an individual player. There will be drills, stations, contests, and games to work on all the skills taught. This camp will have multiple players and coaches assisting at every session and will help make the campers experience a positive one, while also making them better.

These two camps combined will help a player meet whatever goals they have in basketball. If they want to someday play college, high school, traveling team, or just for fun, these camps will help lead them in the right direction.
